(GNM ENTRANCE EXAMINATION, 2024)

ADMISSION INTO GNM COURSE IN BOTH GOVT. AND PRIVATE INSTITUTES UNDER THE DIRECTORATE OF HEALTH SERVICES, ASSAM FOR THE SESSION – 2024-2025

Applications are invited from the candidates for GNM Entrance Examination (GNMEE) for selection of candidates for admission into GNM Course under Directorate of Health Services, Assam in both Govt. and Private Institutes for the session 2024-25. Online Application Form shall be available at Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences website: www.ssuhs.in from 10-05-2024 to 10-06-2024. The Online Application Form must be filled up after carefully going through the instructions given along with the form in the website. The Application Form will no longer be available after 10-06-2024. So, interested candidates are advised to submit the online form within this stipulated period only.

The Entrance Test is going to be held on 14-07-2024 (Sunday) at Guwahati, Dibrugarh, Silchar, Jorhat, Barpeta, Tezpur, Diphu, Lakhimpur and Kokrajhar.

A non-refundable examination fee of Rs. 1500/- (Rupees Fifteen hundred only) is required to be paid by General category candidates and Rs.1200/- (Rupees Twelve hundred only) by candidates belonging to SC/ ST / EWS/ OBC/MOBC including Tai Ahom, Koch Rajbongshi, Moran, Matak, Chutia communities and TGL/Ex-TGL category candidates through the Payment gateway available on online application page and University website (www.ssuhs.in> Fee collect> Student Category > Entrance Examination Fee> GNM)

Above Examination fee is exempted for Divyang (PwD) category of candidates having disability of 40% and above

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Details including Eligibility Criteria and Requirements of the GNM Entrance Examination for selection of Candidates for Admission into GNM Course under the Directorate of Health Services, Assam in both Govt. and Private Institutes for the Session 2024-2025

1. The Entrance Examination shall be held on **14-07-2024 (Sunday)** at Guwahati, Dibrugarh, Silchar, Jorhat, Barpeta, Tezpur, Diphu, Lakhimpur & Kokrajhar for Selection of Candidates for Admission into GNM Course in both Govt. and Private GNM Training Schools under the Directorate of Health Services, Assam which will be conducted by Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences.
2. There will be 1 (one) paper consisting of (a) English (b) Mathematics (c) General Science. The questions of these subjects shall be of 10th standard.
3. The Examination shall be for 100 marks. (100 Questions x 1 Mark each).
English – 50 marks, Mathematics – 25 marks and General Science – 25 marks.
4. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers. Unanswered questions shall be awarded zero marks.
5. The questions will be in both English & Assamese language. However, the candidates will be required to fill in the OMR Sheet of the Entrance Examination in English only.
6. Time of Examination: 11.00 AM to 1.00 PM (Two hours) (**14-07-2024**) (Sunday).

Eligibility criteria for admission into GNM Course in the GNM Training Schools under the

Govt. of Assam:

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December, 2024.
2. The maximum age for admission shall be 35 years.
3. There is no age bar for ANM/LHS
4. The minimum educational qualification for selection of the GNM candidates is
 - a. HSSLC (10+2) or its equivalent passed preferably Science (PCB) & English with aggregate of 40% marks.
 - b. 10+2 in Arts (Mathematics, Biotechnology, Economic, Political Science, History, Geography, Business Studies, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology, Philosophy) and English Core/English Elective or Health Care Science – Vocational stream ONLY, passing out from recognized Board under

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- AISSCE/CBSCE/ICSCE/SSCE/HSCE or other equivalent Board with 40% marks.
- c. 10+2 vocational ANM under CBSE Board or other equivalent Board from the school and recognized by Indian Nursing Council with 40% marks.
 - d. Registered as ANM with State Nursing Registration Council.
5. Student shall be medically fit.
 6. Students qualified in 10+2 Arts or Science examination or Health Care Science – Vocational stream ONLY conducted by National Institute of Open School with 40% marks.
 7. Student shall be admitted once in a year.
 8. The reservation of seats for GNM Training course in Govt. Institutes shall be as per Govt. norms i.e.
 - a. OBC/MOBC – 27%
 - b. STP – 10%
 - c. SC – 7%
 - d. STH – 5%
 - e. EWS – 10%


Besides these, as per Govt. Notification No. HLA.314028/22 dated 24-07-2023, the Government of Assam is pleased to reserve seats for allocation to Tai Ahom, Koch Rajbongshi, Moran, Matak, Chutia Communities and TGL/Ex. TGL which shall be made from the OBC/MOBC reserved category within reservation in GNM Training course for Government Training Schools in the State. They are as follows:

- Tai Ahom Community – 11 seats out of seats reserved for OBC/MOBC
- Koch Rajbongshi Community – 14 seats out of seats reserved for OBC/MOBC
- Moran Community – 10 seats out of seats reserved for OBC/MOBC
- Chutia - 11 seats out of seats reserved for OBC/MOBC
- TGL/Ex. TGL - 20 seats out of seats reserved for OBC/MOBC


However, the distribution and reservation of seats including admission shall be notified by Directorate of Health Services, Assam in due course of time.

Important note:

1. The Entrance Examination shall consist of 100 multiple choice questions (MCQ) and shall be set from the course of Class 10th standard covering English, General Science and Mathematics.
2. The merit list shall be prepared based on the total marks obtained by each candidate in the Entrance Examination. If two or more candidates secure the same mark in the Entrance Examination, the inter-se merit of such candidates shall be determined in order of preference as follows:
 - a. Candidates securing more marks in English in the Entrance Examination.
 - b. Candidates securing more marks in General Science in the Entrance Examination.



- c. If the marks further tally, then marks in English, then General Science, then Mathematics of qualifying examination shall be considered at the time of counselling.
3. The minimum qualifying criteria/ cut off score in the Entrance Examination of **GNM Course** will be as follows:
- i. General (UR/EWS) – 50th Percentile
 - ii. SC/ST/OBC (NCL) – 40th Percentile
 - iii. Divyang – 45th Percentile
4. If seats remain vacant, the minimum percentile will be reassessed by the Govt. of Assam or Directorate of Health Services, Assam.
5. Any information given by the applicant if found to be false, incomplete or any ineligibility criteria detected at any stage later on shall mark her disqualified from the Entrance Examination with all its associated consequences.
6. As the form is to be submitted online, the candidates are not required to send any document to the University, all necessary verification/scrutiny of the related documents of the candidates regarding eligibility; reservation etc. will be done at the time of counseling.
7. The candidates are to keep note of their **Application Form Number and Password**.
8. They are to download the Admit Card from the University website: www.ssuhs.in from **01-07-2024** onwards by entering their Application Form Number and Password.
9. **In case the Application Form Number and Password are misplaced/lost/forgotten by the applicant, she will not be able to download her Admit Card. Hence, the applicants are directed to be very serious in keeping note of the Application Form No. and Password. However, the applicants may call the Help Line No. 7977259728 for any assistance.**
